

NEW TO THE







Session News

Session News and Happenings from May & June, 2022

Your Session met in person on May 17th and June 21st. Each meeting was opened with prayer and a meditation on ministry. Items Approved in our Clerk's Report:

Received into membership: Brad & Kathy Owens (CoT); Lonny & Matt Houff (RF); Chanda (RF), Jeff Sayles and their children Faith and Andrew (CoT); Jaysin Julios (PF) and Jamie Ponapart (RF). <u>Baptism Requested and Performed</u>: Henry Scott & Jack Leroy Langer – 6/12/22; Jaysin & Ovilia Chloe Julios (Father/Daughter) – 6/26/22. <u>Deaths</u>: Alice Johnson (4/27); Steve Walker (5/28). <u>Lord's Supper</u>: Served corporately on 5/1/22 & 6/5/22; individually on 6/1/22.

Items of Discussion coming from our Committees and any Session Actions that were taken:

<u>Nurture/Discipleship</u> reporting on end-of-year activities, VBS, and Summer Youth Events. In May, we welcomed in 5 confirmands into church membership. Thanked all volunteers and staff for their extra work on VBS this year. Thanked Coleen Olmsted for her work as Interim CM Director and approved the hiring of Laura Carlson as our regular CM Director.

<u>Personnel/Finance</u> approved a \$600 Educational Scholarship to graduating Seniors Gavin Larson, Joseph Walker, Annika Nelson, Andrew Sayles, and Terren Baker. Approved April and May Treasurer's Reports from Co-Treasurer, Bill Momsen. Approved Health Care Coverage for Cindy Jayes as a Full Time Non-Ordained Staff Member. An Employee Classification Guideline was presented and was tabled for further discussions. Had discussions on the use of the Hocker Funds to further God's Kingdom.

<u>Facilities/Grounds</u> worked on improving the grounds and clearing out the Shed and the downstairs Boy Scouts closets. Approved repair work for kitchen stove and roof maintenance work from AllWeather Roofing.

<u>Worship/Outreach</u> approved Summer Outdoor Worship for June 19th, July 17th, August 21st and discussed some ways to make this service feel more special. They scheduled Special Music for the Summer and approved getting an annual subscription to Song Select for using contemporary music in our services. They reported on Corn & Pork Fee Community Outreach for 8/24.

<u>Mission/Fellowship</u> approved the following Mission Fund disbursements: Youth Mission Trip - \$3,000; Vacation Bible School - \$500; David Yoon Ministry - \$1000; Cathy Chang -\$500; Ukraine Special Project Fund at Mission Int'l - \$312. They served cake on 5/29 and at the Church BBQ on 6/16. Planned the 4th of July Ice Cream Social. They are keeping our Food Pantry filled on Wednesday and Sundays. Discussed the Food Packing Event on 8/14. <u>General Session Approvals</u>: Parenting Resource Center July Diaper Drive; 4th of July Ice Cream Social for July 4th; Session Meeting on 8/16; Communion change from 1/1/23 to 1/8/23.

Meetings were closed with prayer and the singing of the Doxology.
